



SCHOLARSHIP AWARD PROGRAM

- The Manatee County Cattlemen's Scholarship award program is designed to recognize outstanding accomplishments of students active in the Manatee County Cattlemen's Association.
- This program awards up to two \$1,000 scholarships annually. The scholarship committee will determine how many scholarships will be given, depending on quality and number of applicants.
- Applications must be submitted by students no later than December 1 and the Scholarship award(s) will be presented at the Manatee County Fair awards presentation in January.
- Applicants eligible for consideration must be an active member of the Manatee County Jr. Cattlemen's Association, or their parents must be an active member of the Manatee County Cattlemen's or Cattlewomen's Associations.
- Applicants eligible for consideration must be a high school senior or a re-applying past-year scholarship winner who is currently enrolled in higher education. High school students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and re-applying college students must have a 2.5 GPA.
- Applicants eligible for consideration can be pursuing any field of continued education at a college, university, or technical school.
- Past-year scholarship winners are eligible to re-apply for this annual scholarship. Re-applying students must send in a copy of their grades along with their updated application, to be considered for ongoing scholarships. The maximum scholarships one student may receive throughout their high school and college career is four (i.e.: student could be awarded this scholarship as a high school senior and would then be eligible to re-apply for up to 3 years as a college student).
